Greater Attleboro Taunton Healthy Families by Southeast Massachusetts Council on Addiction (SEMCOA)

- Free and voluntary home visiting program for first time parents 23 years old and under.
- Child development information, education and career support, connections to other young parents, referrals to community resources and more.

Greater Attleboro Area Council for Children

- Promoting the well-being of children and families in need in the Greater Attleboro Area by providing access to essential resources and responsive support services.
- Programs address numerous critical needs and services of families with children of all ages

Early Intervention (EI) programs provide services to families and children from birth to 3 years of age who have, or are at risk for, a delay in development. EI can be in-home or in-center, and services include educational and developmental support for parents and children. More Social Service Organizations

Manet Community Health (Attleboro, Taunton)

- Women's Health – OB/GYN care, family planning counseling, patient education and prenatal care
- Prenatal care services – support a positive pregnancy, birth, and postpartum experience
- Newborn and Well Childcare – pediatric and family medicine practitioners

Family Resource Centers (Attleboro, Taunton)

- Support with childcare options, early childhood development, family support, school services, and mental health.
- Strengthening parenting skills, linking families to services and opportunities, and valuing and supporting parents.

Birthright (Taunton, MA)

- Emotional and material support to anyone who is pregnant or who thinks they may be pregnant.
- Informational resources regarding pregnancy, childbirth, prenatal care, adoption, etc.; referrals for medical support, financial resources, housing, legal assistance, etc.; and material resources like pregnancy tests and maternal and baby items.

- Community education and support for pregnant and parenting people affected by substance use and mental health disorders across southern MA.
- Community diaper bank, car seat donation and installation program, postpartum support group, sibling support group, etc.
